GENERAL CONDITIONS:


any agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 05 ILCS 5/0-4.1, the Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts -- Any agreement shall not be in violation of the provisions of 05 ILCS 5/34-21(b) which restricts the employment of former public employees in the private sector for a period of one year after termination of their public employment.

incorporated into and made a part of any agreement.

Ethics -- The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-R113) as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into any agreement.

Contingent Liability -- Any agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed to be a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.


