

**APPROVE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT IN
GRIER V. CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION, Charge No. 2000CE3045**

THE GENERAL COUNSEL REPORTS THE FOLLOWING SETTLEMENT:

On August 22, 2001, the Law Department has reviewed the settlement agreement between the Board of Education and the Complainant, Luvia Grier, in the lawsuit brought by her against the Board of Education (Charge No. 2000CE3045). The lawsuit was filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, on August 1, 2000. The lawsuit alleges that the Board of Education violated the Complainant's rights under the Illinois Human Rights Act and the Illinois Constitution. The lawsuit also alleges that the Board of Education failed to provide a meaningful opportunity for a hearing. The settlement agreement provides for a monetary payment to the Complainant of \$55,000.00.
