DELIVERABLES: Contractors shall provide abatement services in accordance with specifications for each project.

OUTCOMES: Contractors shall provide environmental projects that improve the health and safety conditions at Chicago Public Schools.

COMPENSATION: The compensation payable to all contractors in the aggregate during this extension period shall not exceed \$12,000 per contractor.
