**OPTION PERIOD:** The agreement

the Department of Human Resources including leasing or fingerprint machines, leased machines, electronically transmitting fingerprints to the Illinois State Police and FBI, within a turnaround time of 48 business days; processing fingerprints as required per month, archiving records to protect against loss, providing sufficient live-scanned technicians and live-scan machines during high volume periods, providing 12 hours/day and 7 days/week management staff to resolve critical issues, performing ongoing fingerprinting at various locations, having qualified staff fully trained live-scan technicians and support technicians, providing training services to Board employees, providing monthly written reports pertaining to the number of persons indoctrinated, electronically transmitting hundreds of hundredths of a dollar to the Board, both annually and quarterly, and reconciling the number of fingerprint services rendered by the Board, many and all instances in which the Illinois State Police cannot read or interpret the results are inconclusive and submitting payment to the Board for their services rendered, providing reconciliation of monthly activity as it pertains to payments associated

with fingerprinting activity and conducting monthly or bi-monthly project meetings to discuss fingerprinting issues or concerns.

**DELIVERABLES:** Consultant will continue to process fingerprints and forward to the appropriate entity for final background checks for the Chicago Public Schools personnel.

**FAIR USE:** One-time consulting services will be used in the future receiving the complete fingerprinting products, which will allow the Board to obtain criminal background checks to provide an effective and innovative pre-employment screening process.

**COMPENSATION:** Consultant shall be paid as follows: \$55.00 per applicant processed; \$1,950.00 for one fingerprinting machine per month (includes technician as needed); and \$1,950.00 for each additional machine (\$1,950.00 includes leasing and maintenance fees \$30.00/hour for the second machine and up). Training is determined by Human Resources at a cost of \$1,000.00/day of training sessions held monthly upon request. Total payments during the option period shall not exceed \$23,000.00.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement between the City and the Consultant. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the notice and all other documents required to administer and effectuate this agreement.

**AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:** This contract is in full compliance with the goals required by the Revised Remedial Enterprise Contract Participation (M/WBE).
