WHEREAS on July 12, 1956, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago (the "Board") joined in the

WHEREAS the Commission provides a means for facilitating the acquisition, construction and maintenance of public improvements, buildings and facilities for use by various governmental agencies in the

WHEREAS the Board has heretofore participated in the acquisition and construction of public schools and other governmental services in cooperation with the Commission and various other facilities to provide for other governmental agencies

Board, the Commission has undertaken the acquisition, construction, alteration, repair, renovation, rehabilitation and equipping of certain public schools and other educational facilities (the "Project") pursuant to the issuance of Building Revenue Bonds, Series A of 1999 Supplement (the "Bonds") and

WHEREAS the Commission has certain properties and interests included in the Project and the Board pays to the Commission rentals sufficient to amortize the principal and interest on the Bonds

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the Project, it is necessary that the Commission enter into an Intergovernmental Easement Agreement with the City of Chicago, a municipal corporation, Department of Sewers, at the school site identified in Exhibit A, which school site has been conveyed to the Commission and is subject to the EASEMENT
