RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF TEACHERS TO FILL TEACHER REPRESENTATIVE VACANCIES IN LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCILS

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the best interests of the County of Stanislaus to amend the Local School Council Act, Chapter 100 of the California Education Code, to require the Local School Councils to fill teacher representative vacancies after considering the preferences of the school staff as ascertained through a non-binding advisory poll of school staff; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the best interests of the County of Stanislaus to amend the Local School Council Act, Chapter 100 of the California Education Code, to require the Local School Councils to fill teacher representative vacancies after considering the preferences of the school staff regarding appointment of teachers to the local school council for that school; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 44211 of the California Education Code, the results of the non-binding advisory poll have been forwarded to the Board for use in its exercise of absolute discretion in the
