GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General. Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 IUC the Inspector General of the Board of Trustees has the authority to conduct certain investigations and the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of 105 II CS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one-year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-FX3) as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU0) as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause: "The undersigned hereby certifies that the undersigned is not a party to any other contract with the Board of Trustees for the same or similar services."
