

ADOPT BOARD RULE 6-32, CHANGE OF AN ATTENDANCE CENTER'S LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTION DATE

The General Counsel recommends adopting Board Rule 6-32 as follows:

DESCRIPTION:

Upon the recommendation of the General Superintendent, the Board may change the date of the first semester report card pick-up day to increase parents' and community involvement as candidates and electors. If the Board adopts the General
