

APPROVE ENTERING INTO AFFILIATION AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS HOSPITALS

TERM: The term of each agreement shall commence on August 31, 2002 and shall end July 31, 2003.

Program is a two-year State approved clinical training. Entrance into the program is on a first-come, first-served basis.
