The Chicago Public Schools and the Chicago Cultural Center have entered into a license and indemnification agreement with EJV Venture for the use of Block 37 site for the period commencing May 1, 2002 through September 24, 2002. Workshops will be scheduled to run Monday through Friday, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and Saturdays, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Students will learn aesthetic appreciation, acquire technical abilities, and establish essential work skills that they will carry with them for life. Visual arts activities will involve drawing, painting, sculpture, and photography.
