

AUTHORIZE THE ACCEPTANCE OF A SPECIAL ASSISTANT UNDER THE NATIONAL URBAN/RURAL FELLOWS MENTORING PROGRAM CLASS OF 2002

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the acceptance of a Special Assistant under the National Urban/Rural Fellows Mentoring Program, Class of 2002, assigned to the Office of the Chief Executive Officer.

DESCRIPTION:

Mr. Cheryl Dawson, National Urban/Rural Fellow, Class of 2002/2003, will be assigned by National Urban/Rural Fellows, Inc. to work in the Office of the Chief Executive Officer during the period of September 3, 2002 through May 30, 2003. The Chief Executive Officer will serve as a mentor to Mr. Dawson as part of a fellowship program that will lead Mr. Dawson to a Master's Degree in Public Administration. The National Urban/Rural Fellows, Inc. (NURF) was founded in 1969 as a cooperative project of Yale University, the National League of Cities, and the U.S. Conference of Mayors, with financial support from the Ford Foundation. It prides itself on providing rigorous academic preparation at the executive level. In its 30-year history, NURF has qualified over 750 men and women for executive positions in public and private institutions across the country and in Europe.
