Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34, the Board has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement is not legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of the Chicago Board of Education's collective bargaining agreement with the Chicago Federation of Teachers, Inc. or any other expiration or other termination of their terms of office during the one year period following the date of the agreement.
