REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Systems Corporation and Central Audio-Visual Services, Inc. are the only vendors currently providing audio-visual equipment and services to the Board of Education. The Board is currently negotiating a contract with Systems Corporation for the purchase of audio-visual equipment and services. The contract is for a period of five years and includes the purchase of all audio-visual equipment, including projectors, AVS, VCRs, audio equipment, other recording and playback devices, equipment for interconnecting all systems, and related services. The contract also includes maintenance and repairs for use by central office departments and schools. The total cost of the contract is not to exceed \$10,000,000.00. These contracts are subject to the Board's Strategic Sourcing Policy. A written renewal agreement for the contract is currently being negotiated.

Approve exercising the first option to renew the agreements with Systems Corporation and Central Audio-Visual Services, Inc. for the purchase of audio-visual equipment and services, including projectors, AVS, VCRs, audio equipment, other recording and playback devices, equipment for interconnecting all systems, and related services, and maintenance and repairs for use by central office departments and schools, at a cost not to exceed \$10,000,000.00. These contracts are subject to the Board's Strategic Sourcing Policy. A written renewal agreement for the contract is currently being negotiated.
