AGREEMENT: The original agreement (authorized by Board Report 01-0725-PR30) in the amount of \$1,144,948 is for a term commencing July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002, with the Board having the option to extend the agreement for 2 one-year periods. The original agreement was awarded on a non-competitive basis because Columbia College jointly developed this federal grant proposal.

OPTION PERIOD: The term of this agreement is being extended for one (1) year commencing July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING: There is one (1) option to renew for one (1) year remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: The consultant will continue to plan, coordinate and provide after-school and summer educational programs for students and parents at the 21st Century Community Learning Centers in five CPS schools. Programming will include educational support in reading and mathematics integrated with the arts. The consultant will provide technical support to the elementary schools and Academy of Communications and Technology at the University of Illinois at Chicago.

DELIVERABLES: During the option period, consultant will operate, oversee and evaluate a 5 Learning Centers and deliver the following:

- Quarterly site-by-site activity performance and progress reports as required by the 21st Century Community Learning Center federal grant.
- Student activity programming: homework assistance, tutorials, summer academic enrichment, extended library service, "living healthy" recreational activities, and cultural activities.
