

HEARING OFFICER'S FINDING THAT PUPIL IS A NON-RESIDENT

ON A TUITION-FREE BASIS (Pupil ID No. 367

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

in effect of the Board's finding... Chicago not entitled to attend the Chicago Public Schools on a tuition-free basis... and (ii) that the Board is authorized and empowered to charge tuition for the pupil... tuition for the pupil... Schools as otherwise allowed by Rule 5-17 on the Rules of the Board unless the required tuition... tuition for the second semester of the 2002-2003 school year, is paid for the pupil; and (3) after due consideration, reject the objections to the Hearing Officer's February 24, 2003, findings filed by the parent of the pupil (ID No. 36737344).

DESCRIPTION: Sections 10-20-12c and 10-20-12b (105 ILCS 5-10-20-12c and 10-20-12b) of the Illinois School Code and Board Rule 5-17 authorize and empower the Board to charge tuition, not exceeding 10% of the per capita... Schools determined to be non-residents of the City of Chicago. Further, section 10-20-12b provides that a pupil, to determine whether or not a pupil... hearing be held when requested by the person who enrolled the pupil... non-resident resides with his school... District... after notice of the hearing... determination of non-residency, the person who enrolled the pupil does not request a hearing or, if requested, the person who enrolled the pupil... hearing results... hearing... does not reside in the period of non-resident school attendance and the pupil shall be barred from attending school in the district unless the required tuition is paid for the pupil.

FINANCIAL: If the pupil is found to have been a non-resident, the person(s) who enrolled the pupil shall be charged tuition for that time.

in accordance with 105 ILCS 5-14-131, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.
