

OMNIBUS REPORT: AUTHORIZE THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANTS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the acceptance of the following grants from the following sources for the following users:

- 1. **FUNDING SOURCE:** Illinois State Board of Education
- RECEIVING SCHOOL/UNIT:** Office of Specialized Services
- AMOUNT:** \$487,069
- PURPOSE:** **To implement the Early Childhood Training and Technical Assistance Project (STAR NET):** to provide technical assistance and training to administrators, teachers in preschool special education, early childhood regular primary education, parents, and community service providers who

assist children with special needs and their families. This grant includes funding for the employment of a Project Director, two (2) Resource Specialists, a Family Resource Specialist and an Educational Support Clerk.

AMOUNT: \$55,886

PURPOSE: To pay the salary of an **Exelon Fellow who will serve as a teacher-on-loan**. The outstanding CPS teacher who will be selected as the Exelon Fellow will guide teachers and students in a variety of seasonal stewardship

6. FUNDING SOURCE: John H. Stroger, Jr. Hospital

RECEIVING SCHOOL/UNIT: Office of Education-to-Careers (ETC)

AMOUNT: \$3,480

PURPOSE: To provide **corporate sponsorship of five (5) interns for Mayor Daley's Summer Kidstart Program**, which seeks to place students in summer jobs related to their career interests.

PURPOSE: To contribute to the development of an internet-based query system designed to allow CHA tenants in particular, and the general public, the ability to find school attendance areas, given specific residential addresses. GPS is a partner with the CHA in the development of the CHA "The Right

Moves Net" which was developed to assist CHA tenants in better planning
