

**AUTHORIZE LICENSE/USAGE AGREEMENTS FOR USE OF VARIOUS SITES
TO OPERATE CHILD FIND SCREENING/OUTREACH ACTIVITIES**

PROGRAM: Pursuant to federal mandate of the Individual with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and the Illinois Administrative Code 226.510, the Board is required to locate and evaluate children within local attendance areas who may require special education and/or related services.

The Office of Specialized Services has established early childhood child find teams to comply with these mandates and to provide screening services. Teams composed of professionals
