**SCOPE OF SERVICES:** Each agency will provide the following services to a minimum of nine (9) high schools: individual, group and family consulting, case management, evaluation and coordination of social services and parent training and support for students and families identified in the adjudication process as chronic absentees. Agencies shall also provide home visits, reviews and screening of students.

**DELIVERABLES:** Agencies shall provide case management which includes an assessment of

and monitoring the delivery of services to children and families; and an evaluation of the effectiveness of services provided.

COMPENSATION: The agencies will be paid as periodic invoices are submitted and verified, in amounts not to exceed \$350,000,00 in aggregate
