THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

~~Approve entering into an agreement with Reith Riley Construction Co., Inc. to provide asphalt and~~

concrete services to the Department of Operations at a cost not to exceed \$5,097,792.00. Vendor was selected pursuant to a duly advertised Bid Solicitation (Specification 01-250327). A written agreement for Vendor's services is available for signature. No payment shall be made to Vendor prior to the execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement and the extension agreement. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreement and the extension agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: *The MWBE goals for this contract include:*

26% total MBE, 16% total African American, 7.5% total Hispanic, 2% total Asian and 5% total WBE

However, the Waiver Review Committee recommends that a partial waiver of the participation goals for this contract be granted by the Revised Remedial Plan for Minority and Women Business Enterprises

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations, and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former
