**AND ADOPT A NEW POLICY FOR AWARDING HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT AND PLACEMENT
FOR HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL COURSES TAKEN IN ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That the Board adopt a new policy for Awarding High School Credit and Placement for High School Level-

recommendation; a grade of C or higher for the duration of the class; maintaining attendance that exceeds the system wide average; completion of all necessary course requirements including daily class assignments and homework.

- A. Students who elect to obtain high school credit for advanced coursework, will be eligible to earn up to four credits toward high school graduation provided the student has met all of the

prerequisites and successfully completed the aforementioned examination. Students who meet these requirements will receive credit for completion of the regular level high school course, and will be placed in the regular level high school course which sequentially follows the course in the curriculum. Students wishing to be placed in honors level classes must complete a placement exam at the receiving high school. These credits will be included on the student's high school transcript. These credits will be included in the determination of the student's high school grade point average. Students may earn no more than one credit in a content area.
