

**APPROVE EXERCISING THE FIRST OPTION TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT WITH CHICAGO UNITED INDUSTRIES LTD. FOR THE PURCHASE OF DISHWASHING EQUIPMENT**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Approve exercising the first option to extend the agreement with Chicago United Industries Ltd. for the purchase of dishwashing equipment for the Department of Operations- Food Services and Warehousing at a cost not to exceed \$150,000 during the first option period.
