Approve entering into agreements with various agencies and universities listed below ("Providers"), to provide after-school programs and services to twenty-two (22) schools for the Office of After School Programs at a total cost of \$4,004,000 in the aggregate. Providers were selected on a non-competitive basis because

of their prior working relationship with each school and previous history with community school initiatives

TERM: The term of each agreement shall commence on October 28, 2004 and shall end June 30, 2005. The term of the agreement for Oakdale Community Development Corporation shall commence February 23, 2005 and end June 30, 2005. The Board shall have the right to extend the contracts for four (4) successive one year periods.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT: The Board shall have the right to terminate each agreement with 30 days written notice.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Providers will work with participating schools to fulfill the goals of the CPS 21st Century Learning Centers initiative including the following: (1) Improve the physical, social and emotional well-being of participating students and (2) Improve student academic development and performance. To accomplish these goals, schools and their Providers will provide a safe, supervised environment within the
