

ADJUST ATTENDANCE AREA BOUNDARIES AND CHANGE ASSOCIATED SMALL SCHOOLS FOR ORR CAMPUS HIGH SCHOOL AND ESTABLISH PHOENIX MILITARY ACADEMY AS A MULTI-ATTENDANCE AREA HIGH SCHOOL

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective August 1, 2005, adjust attendance area boundaries and change the associated small schools for Rezin Orr Campus High School located at 730 N Dulock Road. Establish Phoenix Military Academy located at 145 S Campbell as

multi-attendance area high school.

DESCRIPTION:

The Phoenix Military Academy will cease to occupy the Orr Campus. Incoming ninth graders residing within the Orr Campus attendance area will have a choice of attending the small schools of Moses Vines, AASTA, and Excel. Students currently enrolled at Phoenix Military Academy will have the option of attending these three schools or continue to remain enrolled in Phoenix Military Academy. Phoenix Military Academy will become a multi-attendance area high school housed in the
