

RATIFY EXERCISING THE FIRST OPTION TO RENEW THE AGREEMENTS WITH DEPAUL UNIVERSITY AND WITS AND APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CITY YEAR FOR TUTORING SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Ratify exercising the first option to renew the agreements with DePaul University and WITS and approve

entering into an agreement with an additional consultant, City Year, to provide tutoring services to the Office of Instruction and School Management at a cost not to exceed \$265,000 in the aggregate. Written extension agreements for DePaul University and WITS and an original agreement for City Year's services are currently being negotiated. City Year was selected on a non-competitive basis because of the quality of their previous services. No payment shall be made to any Consultant prior to the execution of such Consultant's extension agreement or original agreement as applicable. The authority granted herein shall

automatically rescind in the event written agreements are not executed within 90 days of the date of this

CITY YEAR TERM: The term for City Year shall commence on September 28, 2005 and shall end June 30, 2006. This agreement shall have one option to renew for a period of one (1) year.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: East Community Center shall provide the following services to Chicago Public Schools (CPS) students, as follows.

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Tutoring Services

1. Recruit and train volunteers to provide instructional support that is tied to the (CPS) curriculum.
2. Provide one-to-one or small group, site-based tutoring services to elementary and high school students.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS

investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Section 10-10. The agreement shall be subject to all provisions of the Department of State's "Policy on"
