**SCOPE OF SERVICES:** Partners will work with participating schools to fulfill the goals of the CPS 21<sup>st</sup> Century

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board member during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (05-0728-FY2) as amended from time

to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.
