APPROVE SETTLEMENT OF DEBARMENT PROCEEDINGS AGAINST COLLINS MAINTENANCE INC. AND DEBORAH COLLINS BY ACCEPTANCE OF VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION

Trucking, Inc. and Roland Harper ("R.O.H.A.R. Respondents") for allegedly engaging in conduct that

Landscape Company, Inc., to participate in sheltered market opportunities that were not otherwise available to it, and to wrongfully benefit the Collins Respondents, who performed no work for the Board.

The Monahan Respondents and the R.O.H.A.R. Respondents were debarred by the Board at its meeting on February 28, 2007, after the Hearing Officer found them in default. See 07–0228–AR8.

The Collins Respondents, who appeared before the Hearing Officer to contest the entry of debarment by default, have agreed to a 20-month period of voluntary exclusion under Section 3.1 of the Board's
