

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CHICAGO TRANSIT
AUTHORITY RELATING TO THE CTA STUDENT SMART CARD PROGRAM**

THE BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES REQUESTS APPROVAL OF THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

Approve entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Chicago Transit Authority to provide each high school student with a CTA "smart card" permit at a cost not to exceed \$500,000 for FY09. The Smart Card is usable on CTA buses and trains, stores monetary value, and allows a student to ride the CTA at a reduced fare. This permit would be combined with the student identification card now issued to all high school students and include the student's name and photograph. A written agreement is currently being


