
FINAL 08-0827-PR6 August 27, 2008 APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY RELATING TO THE CTA STUDENT SMART CARD PROGRAM Approve entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Chicago Transit Authority to provide each high school student with a CTA "smart card" permit at a cost not to exceed \$500,000 for FY09. The Smart Card is usable on CTA buses and trains, stores monetary value, and allows a student to ride the CTA at a reduced fare. This permit would be combined with the student identification card now issued to all high school students and include the student's name and photograph. A written agreement is currently being

b. On the face of each CTA Smart Card that CPS issues to an eligible student, the CPS shall print, or cause to be printed, the name, photograph and identification number of the eligible student. This printing cost shall be borne by the CPS.
