**APPROVE HEARING OFFICER'S FINDING THAT PUPILS ARE NON-RESIDENTS
OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO NOT ENTITLED TO ATTEND THE
CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS ON A TUITION-FREE BASIS**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That the Chicago Board of Education: adopt the November 3, 2008, findings of the Board-appointed Hearing Officer from a Pupil Residency Hearing held October 15, 2008, that: (i) pupils (ID #37958573) and (ID# 00484042) are non-residents of the City of Chicago and are not entitled to attend the Chicago Public Schools on a tuition-free basis; and (ii) the pupils' parents, as the persons who enrolled the pupils, are indebted to the Board for non-resident tuition for the pupils' attendance in the Chicago Public Schools since September 2006 to June 2008 in the total amount of \$26,429.07 for 2006-2007 to 2007-2008; reject any objections by the parents to the hearing officer's findings; and bar the pupils from continued attendance in the Chicago Public Schools unless and until all non-resident tuition owed is paid in full.

Schools on a tuition-free basis; and (ii) the pupils' parents, as the persons who enrolled the pupils, are indebted to the Board for non-resident tuition for the pupils' attendance in the Chicago Public Schools since September 2006 to June 2008 in the total amount of \$26,429.07 for 2006-2007 to 2007-2008; reject any objections by the parents to the hearing officer's findings; and bar the pupils from continued attendance in the Chicago Public Schools unless and until all non-resident tuition owed is paid in full.
