

APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ACCURATE BIOMETRICS FOR FINGERPRINTING SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Accurate Biometrics to provide fingerprinting services to the Department of Human Resources at a cost not to exceed \$650,000. Consultant was selected on a competitive basis pursuant to Board Rule 5-4.1. A written agreement for Consultant's services is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by Consultant and no payment shall be made to Consultant prior to the execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Report.
