

APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW TEACHER CENTER - NTC FOR CONSULTING SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with the New Teacher Center (NTC) to provide consulting services to the Chicago Public Schools (CPS) at a cost not to exceed \$3.5 million. Consultant was selected on a non-competitive basis due to their expertise in providing coach training and their prior experience providing ~~coach training to the Chicago Public Schools. A written agreement for Consultant's services is currently~~

being negotiated. No services shall be provided by Consultant and no payment shall be made to Consultant prior to the execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this
