THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:


Approve entering into an agreement with Chicago Arts Partnerships in Education (CAPE) to provide professional development, support services and materials to the Office of Academic Enhancement at a cost not to exceed \$305,384.00. CPS was awarded a Department of Education Arts in Education Model Development and Dissemination grant for teacher professional development based on a proposal written by CAPE. The title of the

project is International Baccalaureate Teaching Arts Project (IB-TAP). Over the past four years, CAPE has partnered with CPS and EDAMG schools on other grant funded projects entitled Partnership for Arts Integration

collaborative planning with arts and content specialists. As a result of their experiences, teachers will:

- Be able to articulate standards and learner profile characteristics in their own area of expertise and in the areas of their partners;


