

AMEND BOARD REPORT 10-0428-PR40
**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS VENDORS FOR THE PURCHASE OF
RESPONSE TO INTERVENTION SERVICES(RTI)**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into agreements with various vendors for the purchase of Response to Intervention (RTI) materials and services for District 299 at an aggregate cost not to exceed \$30,000,000.00. Vendors were selected on a competitive basis pursuant to a duly advertised Request for Proposals (Specification No. 10-250007). Written agreements for these services and materials are currently being negotiated. No

goods and/or services may be ordered or received and no payment shall be made to any Vendor prior to execution of their written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as to each Vendor in the event their written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this amended Board Report. Information pertinent to these agreements is stated below.
