
August 18, 2009. The hearing was recorded and a summary report is available for review.

On September 28, 2009, YCCS submitted a proposal to establish a new high school campus. YCCS King Drive and to increase their overall at capacity enrollment by 250 students to 3750. The campus is scheduled to open in January 2011 and in its first year will serve 150 students in grades 9-12. The school will grow to serve 250 students in grades 9-12 at capacity. In June 2010 YCCS submitted a material modification to relocate the West Town Academy Alternative
