

APPROVE ENTERING INTO A TEACHER REFERRAL AND SUPPORT AGREEMENT WITH TEACH FOR AMERICA

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

~~Approve entering into a teacher referral and support agreement with Teach for America (TFA) to provide~~

200 provisionally-certified teachers to Chicago Public Schools at a cost not to exceed \$600,000.00. Vendor was selected on a non-competitive basis: the sole-source request was presented to the Non-Competitive Procurement Review Committee, and was approved by the Chief Purchasing Officer. A written agreement is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by TFA and no payment shall be made to TFA prior to the execution of the written agreement. OUTCOMES:

At the end of the 2011-2012 school year, a maximum of 200 teacher-interns will be eligible to receive their Illinois Initial Alternative Teaching Certificate and continued employment by Chicago Public Schools.

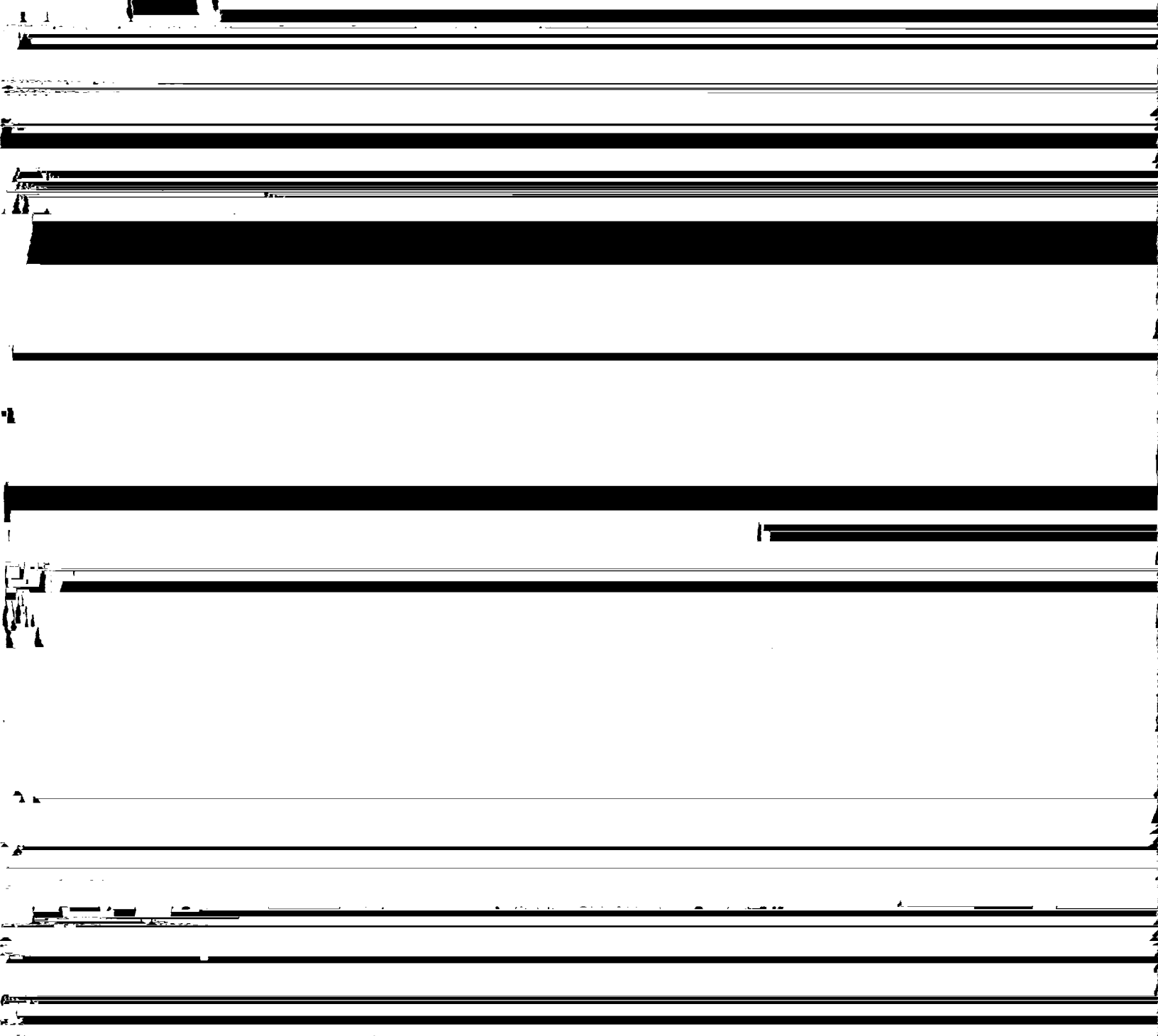
COMPENSATION:
