

APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ILLINOIS CAUCUS FOR ADOLESCENT

HEALTH FOR TRAINING, YOUTH DEVELOPMENT, AND IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Illinois Caucus for Adolescent Health (ICAH) to provide training

youth development, and implementation services to the Office of Special Education and Supports at a

city-wide social media campaign and contacting media to arrange for placement of ads and public service announcements. The YAC will oversee the recruitment of youth volunteers to provide feedback to the Youth Engagement Specialist on the development of the website and advertisements for the social media campaign.

ICAH will facilitate the development of Peer Health Ambassadors (PHA). PHAs are CPS students who have successfully completed the TOP and are interested in further promoting the TOP message as well

as addressing other teen health issues. Eight students per school will be selected to become PHA's through an application process and will be reimbursed for up to five meetings per year. The ICAH Youth

Engagement Specialist will supervise this work and assist in the development and implementation of least


