

**AMEND BOARD REPORT 10-0224-PR16**  
**RATIFY ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CHICAGO POLICE**

**DEPARTMENT FOR SCHOOL PATROL SERVICES**

Ratify entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Chicago Police Department of the City of Chicago (CPD) to provide school police services at 96 high schools and 1 special school at a cost to the Board of \$32.8 million not to exceed \$102,800,000.00 for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2012, of which \$16.9 million will be credited as indicated below. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES:**

CPD will provide sworn full-duty officers for 8-hour tours at designated school sites. Designated assignments will be determined by the Superintendent of CPD in consultation with the Board. CPD will provide computer terminal connected to the CPD network for processing juvenile offenders assigned to

the Chicago Public Schools where on-duty CPD officers are assigned. The Board will provide secure office space at each school where officers are assigned for the purpose of securing CPD computer equipment and processing juvenile offenders.

Authorize the General Council to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement
