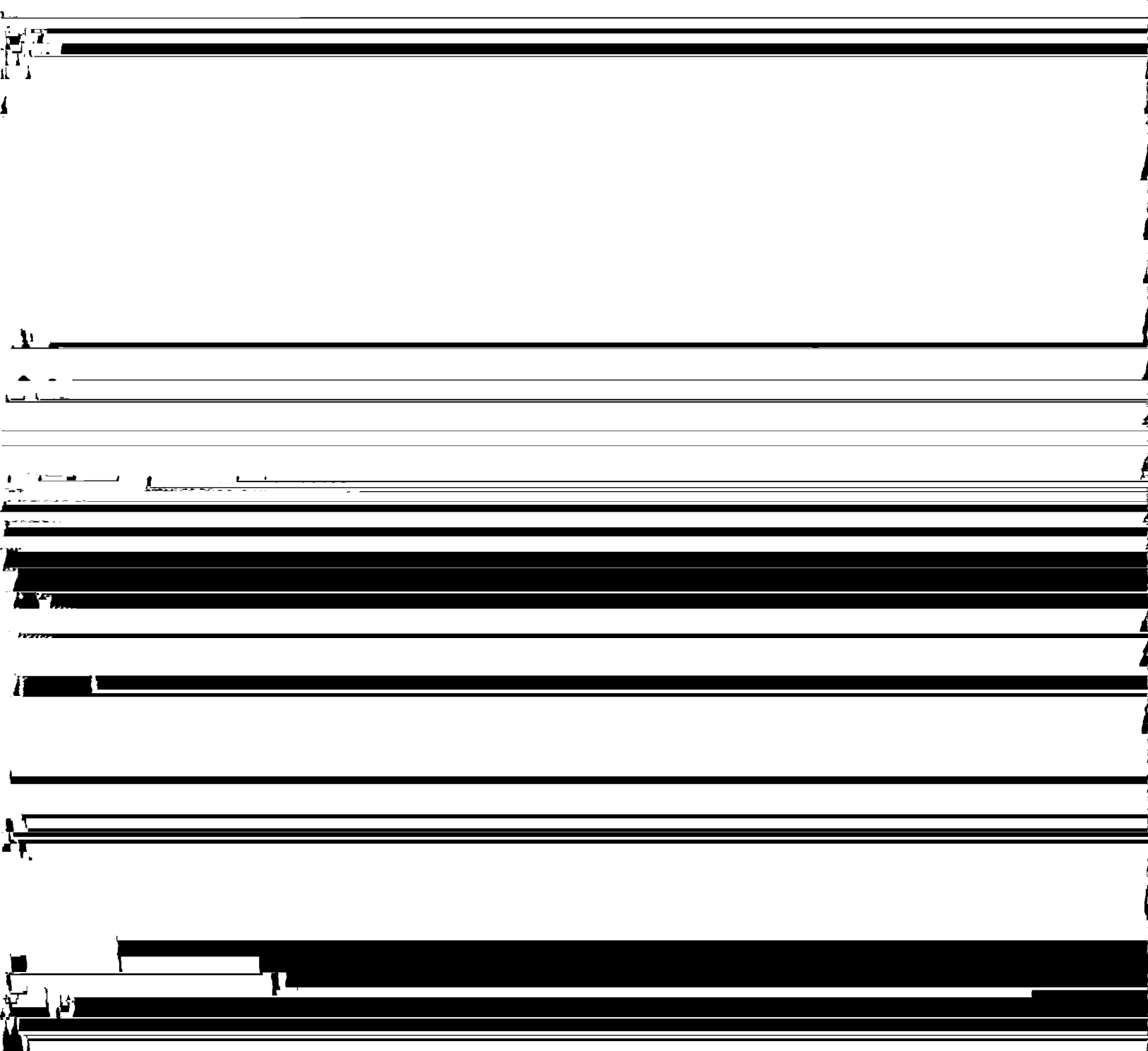


ADOPT A NEW ASTHMA MANAGEMENT POLICY

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

That the Board adopt a new Asthma Management Policy.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this policy is to promote the prevention of asthmatic reactions and daily management of asthma during school and school related activities. This policy also establishes training



send written notification to the parent/guardian of the student's EAAP. The school shall follow all additional procedures set out in the Asthma Guidelines for parents/guardian of a student with asthma who declines a 504 Plan.


Non-Cooperation: If the parent/guardian of a student with asthma fails or refuses to cooperate

~~with the school for an evaluation or implementation of an appropriate 504 Plan or any documentation~~

required to offer a 504 Plan, the school shall implement a simple Emergency Asthma Action Plan (EAAP) stating to call 911 immediately upon recognition of emergency signs and symptoms along with sending
