

**APPROVE EXTENDING THE AGREEMENT WITH KRONOS INCORPORATED FOR SOFTWARE AND  
HARDWARE MAINTENANCE**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Approve extending the agreement with Kronos Incorporated ("Kronos" or "Vendor") for the purchase of

software and hardware maintenance for district-wide time-keeping Kronos clocks at a cost for the extension period not to exceed \$369,991.58. A written extension document is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Vendor during the extension period prior to the execution of the written document. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written document is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. Information pertinent to this extension is stated below.

2013. The original agreement was awarded on a non-competitive basis because the hardware is proprietary to Kronos and has previously been implemented throughout the district.

**EXTENSION PERIOD:**

The term of this agreement is being extended for one year commencing July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014.

**OPTION PERIODS REMAINING:**

There are no options remaining.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

Kronos will continue to provide critical maintenance on the WorkForce TimeKeeper system and depot repair maintenance on the smart converter and keypad system. Kronos will continue to provide software support to ensure the operating systems function properly, and will provide quarterly optimizations and

enhancements that Kronos may develop during this extension term as long as the Board's maintenance
