COMPENSATION:

Vendor shall be paid in accordance with the unit prices contained in the agreement; estimated annual costs for the three (3) year term are set forth below:

\$1,250,000, FY16

\$3,000,000, FY17

\$3,000,000, FY18

Not to exceed \$9,000,000 over the three (3) year term.

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorize the General Council to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement.

Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreement. Authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:
