**RESCIND BOARD REPORT 14-0326-PO1
AND ADOPT A NEW VOLUNTEER POLICY**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

~~That the Board rescind Board Report 14-0326-PO1 and adopt new Volunteer Policy~~

PURPOSE: This policy shall: (1) ensure that prospective volunteers are properly vetted and approved annually; (2) ensure that volunteers do not pose undue risk to the health and safety of CPS students and (3) ensure that CPS Principals are responsible for ensuring that volunteers are properly vetted and

approved in advance and that approved volunteers are properly supervised while serving as volunteer.

II. Principal Responsibilities:

A. For Level I and II Volunteers: The principal shall be responsible for all volunteers associated with their school, including those providing services outside of regular school hours.


1. The principal is responsible for reviewing volunteer application forms from eligible prospective volunteers, completing an interview, as necessary, with the prospective volunteer or his/her sponsoring corporation or other organization and determining whether to recommend the individual for volunteer service to FACF. Decisions about recommending volunteers shall be made based






