

~~AUTHORIZE THE PRE-QUALIFICATION STATUS OF AND NEW AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS~~

VENDORS FOR MOVING SERVICES

Authorize the pre-qualification status of and new agreements with various vendors to provide moving services to the Department of Facilities at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of this report. No services shall be provided by and no payment shall be made to any Vendor prior to the execution of their written master agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as to each Vendor in the event their written master agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. TERM:

The term of each agreement shall commence on October 1, 2018 and shall end September 30, 2021. The agreements shall have two (2) options to renew for periods of one (1) year each.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT:

The Board shall have the right to terminate each agreement with thirty (30) days written notice.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendors shall provide moving services to Chicago Board of Education facilities. Moving services will be provided in five categories:

(1) General moves include all labor, packing materials, equipment, transportation and supervision to move furniture, fixtures, equipment and boxes.

(2) Office and workstation moves include all labor, packing material, equipment, transportation and

equipment, transportation and supervision.

Log of all equipment and materials installed and maintained.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one-year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of

office.

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted May 25, 2011 (11-0525-PO2), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.
