AUTHORIZE A NEW AGREEMENT WITH SAGA INNOVATIONS, INC.

FOR IN-CLASS MATH TUTORING SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize a new agreement with SAGA Innovations, Inc. to provide in-class math tutoring services to at-risk students at an estimated annual cost set forth in the compensation section of this report. Vendor was selected on a non-competitive basis. This item was presented to the Single/Sole Source Committee on February 14, 2019 and approved by the Chief Procurement Officer. EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT:

The Board shall have the right to terminate this agreement with 30 days written notice.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendor will provide an intensive, high dosage tutoring program that both personalizes and differentiates

instruction for every student based on their academic needs and individual learning styles and will utilize a

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary

to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one-year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.
