

AUTHORIZE A NEW AGREEMENT WITH LUMITY FOR STUDENT APPRENTICESHIP SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorizing a new agreement with Lumity to provide career and job readiness training and

apprenticeship jobs to Chicago Public School students at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of this report. Vendor was selected on a non-competitive basis. This request was

presented to the Single/Sole Source Committee on March 29, 2019 and approved by the Chief Procurement Officer consistent with Board Rule 7-6. Prior to approval as a Single Source, the item was

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendor will provide 50 CPS students with an opportunity for career and job experiences training and

apprenticeship jobs with tech and manufacturing companies. Students will receive hourly wages for their participation and upon completion and CPS graduation, will receive a permanent full time job. The Lumity
