

**AUTHORIZE THE SECOND AND FINAL RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH VARIOUS VENDORS FOR
VIRTUAL LEARNING ONLINE COURSES**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REQUESTS THAT THE BOARD

Authorize the second and final renewal agreement with various vendors to provide virtual learning online

courses to schools at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of this report. A written document exercising this option is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to

Vendors during the entire period prior to execution of the written document. The written document shall
