

AUTHORIZE A NEW AGREEMENT WITH LAKESHORE RECYCLING SYSTEMS, LLC FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL, RECYCLING, AND COMPACTOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES

The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT:

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendor will provide collection, processing and disposal of solid waste and recyclable materials from designated locations (including garbage, solid waste and refuse). Vendor will provide monthly preventative maintenance to the Board's compactors and will quote and perform repairs to those compactors as requested by the Board.
